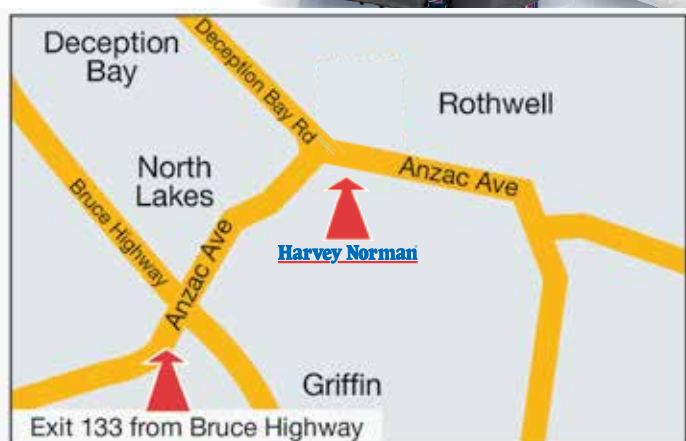

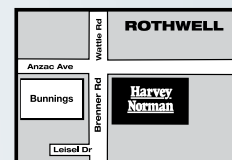

### ACTIVE MORETON OFFERS 15,500+ SPOTS IN REGION'S SPORT AND HEALTH PROGRAM

Moreton Bay Regional Council has unveiled its largest-ever offering of free and low-cost activities for locals as part of its newly announced Healthy and Active Moreton program.

More than 760 activities, from scuba diving and surfing, to mum and bubs soccer and cooking, will be on offer over six months, with many activities back by popular demand.

Parks, Sport and Recreation Spokesperson Councillor Koliana Winchester said from July, more than 15,500 places would be available across the 768 activities delivered by more than 75 local providers, including 31 local clubs and organisations.

Bicycle Queensland data shows lowering the speed limit reduces deaths and serious injuries from crashes, with nearly 800 cyclists are injured on Queensland roads each year, costing the economy over \$220 million annually.

The data, taken from the Queensland Road Crash Database, finds that in Brisbane's CBD, lowering the speed limit from 50km/hr to 40km/hr in 2009 significantly reduced the severity of road crash injuries for cyclists.

Bicycle Queensland CEO Anne Savage said the data backed up the international evidence that lowering speed limits saves lives.

"Lower speed limits save lives – we applaud the commitments made this morning by both LNP and Labor councillors on this and would welcome bipartisan action," she said.

"Analysis of road crash data has proven that a 10km/hr reduction in the speed limit reduced the average crash cost in car crashes involving a cyclist in the Brisbane CBD by \$30,000 per crash, from about \$250k to \$220k – lowering the number of fatalities and serious injuries over a five-year period.

"International evidence demonstrates that on most roads, in most countries, 40-50 per cent of all cars travel above the speed limit, and someone who is hit by a vehicle traveling at 80km/hr has a three times higher risk of dying than if they had been hit by a vehicle moving at 50km/hr.

"According to United Nations data, even just a five

**Bicycle Queensland has backed a call by Labor councillors for a trial of 30km/hr speed limit in Brisbane's CBD, following a number of tragic incidents in recent months, including two fatalities.**

per cent cut in the average speed reduces the number of fatal crashes by 30 per cent, and 47 countries have already implemented lower urban speed limits and laws that allow local authorities to further reduce speed li

mits to protect people on foot and riding bikes.

"International experts – including the United Nations – recommend setting speed limits at 30km/hr or lower when motorised traffic mixes with pedestrians and bike riders.

"Setting the Brisbane CBD speed limit at 30km/hr would save lives and help to stop vehicles rushing through traffic lights to try and beat peak-hour gridlock.

"Lowering speed limits in urban areas with high numbers of people on foot and on bicycle would save many lives and prevent crashes.

"47 countries around the world have already

implemented these commonsense practices, but we must do far more to protect vulnerable road users by developing infrastructure and laws that discourage high-risk driving.

"Concerted investment to improve on-road bike lanes and build new separated cycleways is also critical – providing lifesaving protection for pedestrians and cyclists and eliminating risks of collisions involving motor vehicles – giving all road users greater peace of mind.

"While individual awareness is important, I cannot emphasise strongly enough the fact that if a vehicle impacts with a pedestrian or bike rider at a slower speed, the person is likely to survive and suffer less serious injuries.

"We can reach the goal of zero deaths on our roads and in the Brisbane CBD, but we need to lower the speed limit and create protected pathways for pedestrians and cyclists."

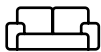

## WAITING FOR LIFE TO HAPPEN

Hello Leonie,

I download your column each week as we don't get the Messenger on Bribie. I was just re-reading an article of yours on life coaching. # MORETON BAY UNI CONSTRUCTION OFFICIALLY UNDERWAY

USC Moreton Bay is on track to open for Semester 1, 2020



Construction of the University of the Sunshine Coast's Petrie Campus is gaining momentum with the opening of the state of the art precinct now only 18 months away.

Last Wednesday USC's Vice-Chancellor Professor Greg Hill today hosted a commencement ceremony at the site of the campus expected to have a student population of 10,000 by 2030.

Federal Member for Dickson Peter Dutton, Federal Member for Petrie Luke Howarth and Minister for Education and Training Simon Birmingham attended the ceremony to mark the start of construction of stage 1 of the new campus – a three-storey foundation building with more than 16,000 square metres of floor space – will soon take shape on land adjacent the Petrie railway station.

Professor Hill praised each of the dignitaries for the significant roles they have played in enabling USC Moreton Bay, which will bring unprecedented access to tertiary education for residents of the region.

"Moreton Bay is one of Queensland's fastest growing regions, but is the only region of its size in Australia without its own full-service university campus," he said.

"USC Moreton Bay represents an exciting opportunity to harness the region's potential, and significantly boost educational opportunities for local residents."

Professor Hill said USC already had a strong connection with Moreton Bay, with almost 1,000 new students from the region starting at the University's campuses on the Sunshine Coast and Caboolture in Semester 1 this year

He said USC Moreton Bay's initial undergraduate, postgraduate, and research programs would have an employment focus to ensure benefits flow quickly to the wider community.

"As the Caboolture and Moreton Bay campuses grow, we will work closely with local schools, industries and community groups to ensure we deliver study options that meet the region's needs, and prepare graduates for the opportunities for a changing economy," he said.

The said it was great to see construction of this important project underway.

"In just over 18 months this site will be a thriving and bustling university precinct," Mr Dutton said.

"It's exciting to think that thousands of students from northern Brisbane and the southern Moreton Bay region will soon have the opportunity to attend university in their own backyard.

"Whilst this opens up opportunities for local students, we've also started to see the value of the Petrie campus for local businesses and this will only increase when the campus is up and running."

The Federal Member for Petrie Luke Howarth said it's very exciting to be turning the sod and acknowledged that without the support of the Federal Government, this project would not have happened.

"Thousands of young people in the Moreton Bay region will benefit over the decades ahead from the Federal Coalition Government's strong support for this University campus." Mr Howarth said.

The Minister for Education and Training Simon Birmingham said the Coalition Government's funding for the construction works in addition to its commitment early this year of \$69.4 million for bachelor places from 2020 would give students from the Dickson, Petrie and Longman electorates the choice to study locally.

"Local students will soon have access to higher education opportunities across more than 50 study programs designed to help them secure jobs locally and to ultimately create more jobs locally," Mr Birmingham said.

"These Turnbull Government investments will also enable USC to work with local industries and build collaborative partnerships to produce skilled graduates that meet the region's needs.

"I expect the USC Petrie campus to transform collaboration with local industries and to also become a key hub for research and innovation for the Moreton Bay region.

"While the Turnbull Government has been committed



to this new campus since before the last election, Labor has recently been trying to play catch up yet have still refused to match all of the investments we're making."

The Government's support for the USC Petrie Campus includes \$69.4 million for 1,200 bachelor degree places in 2020, then 2,400 bachelor places in 2021 and 3,600 ongoing places from 2022. This is on top of a \$35 million grant to the Moreton Bay Regional Council for infrastructure support and a \$121 million loan facility to USC at concessional rates.

The USC Moreton Bay Regional University Precinct will include contemporary interactive teaching and learning spaces and a research and innovation hub.

The first intake of students, expected to be as many as 1,200, will have a choice of almost 50 study programs including business, education and computer science.

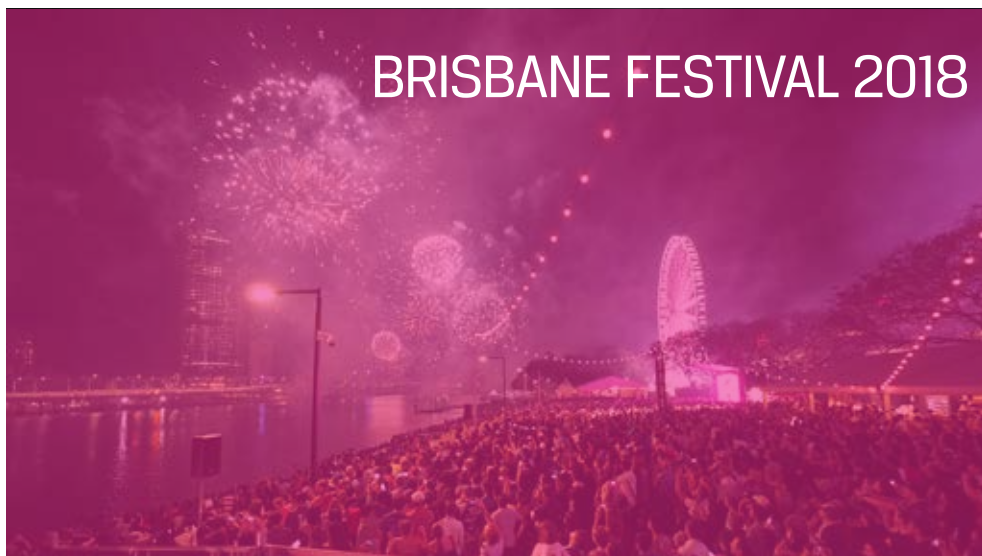
**B**risbane Festival is Queensland's largest cultural event, attracting an audience of around one million people every year and is set to be better than ever before this year.

## SUNNY DAYS AHEAD WITH INTEREST FREE SOLAR LOANS

**Interest free loans for Queensland families to install solar systems and slash their power costs**

Interest free loans are now available to Queensland families who want to install solar systems on their roofs, said Chris Whiting MP.

This new program under the Palaszczuk Government's Affordable Energy Plan is aimed at Queensland families who need assistance with their power bills.

"3,500 Queensland families will be able to join the solar energy revolution under this bold new scheme," said Chris Whiting.

"Applications for loans of up to \$4,500 are now open to eligible applicants, and must be repaid within 7 years," said Chris Whiting.

To be eligible to apply for an interest-free solar loan applicants must be a homeowner, receive Family Tax Benefit Part B, have electricity costs of more than \$1,000 in the past 6 months, or \$2,000 in the past 12 months.

"Applications close on 30 June 2019, but with limited numbers I encourage all those who are interested and eligible to get their applications in quickly," said Chris Whiting.

"The cost of energy has been a focus of the



Palaszczuk Government, and our efforts are starting to see results, with a fall in energy prices of between 1.3% and 8.6%, depending on the retailer."

"This compares to increases of 43% under the previous Newman LNP Government."

"It also pays to research and shop around with retailers now offering big discounts of up to 30% on your bill," said Chris Whiting."

Customers will need to obtain a quote from an

eligible solar supplier before submitting their application online.

Monthly repayments for \$4500 loan over 7 years are around \$54 per month or \$648 per year.

A 3 kilowatt solar system purchased with an interest free solar loan could save a customer around \$350 per year after loan repayments.




