## MORE CLUES FOR FAMILY HISTORY RESEARCHERS

More than 35,000 visitors per month are accessing the Family History Research service provided by the Queensland Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages.

Now the popular resource has been improved, opening up even more information to family history researchers. The service has been expanded to include access to notes and other documents accompanying official certificates. The site is also now faster and easier to navigate.

The digital service for family history research began on Queensland Day (June 6) five years ago. Prior to that community members would have to attend the Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages in person to apply for documents, which were then retrieved from archives, copied and posted to them, it was laborious.

Researchers and historians are now able to apply for Historical Source Images, which are the notes or any other material provided by the informant. Previously they were only able to access the official record of the birth, death or marriage.

The registry holds records of births, deaths and marriages that took place in Queensland between 1829 and present day.

While Queensland started compulsory registration of life events in 1856, the registry also holds some church records of life events between 1829 and 1855.

This year the program offers even more unique opportunities for visitors to get involved with activities in the medieval the encampment, deepening personal experiences and reinforcing grounding connections with history.

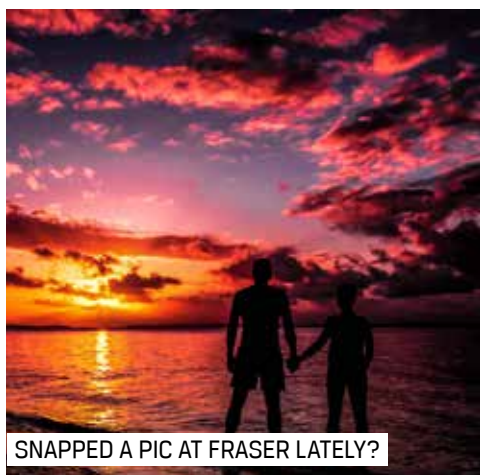

"It's these features that were recognised as internationally significant, and warranted the island's World Heritage listing in 1992," Minister for Environment Leeanne Enoch said.

Conway Burns, a Butchulla spokesperson and talented artist, said he was excited by the opportunity to share the international significance of K'gari with current and future generations.

"K'gari is a female white spirit sent from sky country to help create the lands and is a spiritual place for my people – a place of plenty. Everyone should know how special she is," Mr Burns said.

The 'Snap Up Some Paradise' competition has three categories – Landscapes, Sand & Water and Flora & Fauna. Winners will have the opportunity to become published photographers, with their work showcased in the Fraser Island 2019 Calendar, and in the December 2018 Issue of Wildlife Australia Magazine.

Wamuran State School and North Lakes Goodstart Early Learning Centre (ELC) have been recognised for their efforts recently in reducing general waste and increasing recycling programs as part of Moreton Bay Regional Council's 2017 Sustainability Champions Program.

The program, which started as a pilot last year, aims to recognise schools and early learning centres in the region for their achievements and leadership in sustainable waste management.

Council's Waste Spokesperson, Councillor Adam Hain, said it was fantastic to see young students even as young as three and four embracing recycling and doing their bit to help preserve the wonderful environment of Moreton Bay.

"Our goal through council's Sustainability Champions Program is to discover champion sites from across the region that are minimising waste to landfill and diverting valuable materials to recycling and resource recovery among other sustainable practices," Cr Hain said.

"For instance, just by setting up a compost bin to dispose organic waste, GoodStart ELC was able to decrease waste to landfill by nearly half; from 900kg per week to 530kg per week and double their recycling efforts from 480litres per week to 840 litres per week.

"There were some excellent results at Wamuran State School through their recycling of plastic bottles, cosmetic containers, oral and dental containers as well as mobile phones and accessories that helped them to half their waste

to landfill from about 2500kg per week to 1250kg per week."

Division 4 Councillor Julie Greer said Goodstart worked hard over the year to reduce their general waste and increase their recycling efforts.

"You are never too young to learn how to recycle and care for the environment so I am just so pleased to see our youngest residents taking the time to learn about recycling and caring for our environment," Cr Greer said.

"I want to congratulate each and every one of them along with the teaching staff for making recycling a priority at the centre.

"The best part about programs such as this is that the kids can go home and share what they've learnt with their family, which has a positive flow-on effect to recycling and waste minimisation at home."

Division 12 Councillor Adrian Raedel said when it came to recycling, "Wamuran State School has definitely set the benchmark".

"Last year Wamuran was named Regional Recycler for their Plastic Ocean Funky Fashion video and their recycling efforts certainly haven't waned since then.

"Their efforts teach all of us how we can all play our part in creating a better environment.

For their hard work, both the centre and school received a certificate of achievement and a trophy made from timber recovered at council's waste facility.

## "LARGE BROCCOLI LATTE TO GO, PLEASE"

Will the green stuff make it into your hot stuff?



**G**reen, nutrient-rich coffees may be on the horizon after researchers have developed a powder made from imperfect-looking broccoli that would have previously been wasted.

The product, developed by Hort Innovation and CSIRO, Australia's national science agency, packs a healthy punch with approximately one serve of broccoli in every two tablespoons of powder.

A Melbourne café became the first to experiment brewing a broccoli latte recently, with mixed reviews.

While broccoli lattes might not suit everyone, but Hort Innovation chief executive John Lloyd said the powder could also be used for smoothies, soups, baking and as a way of hiding broccoli from fussy kids in meals.

"With a rising trend in healthy eating across the board, Australian growers are always looking at ways to diversify their products and cut waste while meeting consumer demand," Mr Lloyd said.

He also said despite the increasing popularity of 'superfoods' and health and wellness, Australian diets are still poor.

"Research shows the average Australian is still not eating the recommended daily intake of vegetables a day, and options such as broccoli powder will help address this," he said.

The 100 per cent broccoli powder is made from whole broccoli, and produced using a

combination of selected pre-treatment and drying processes to retain the natural colour, flavour and nutrient composition of fresh broccoli.

Lead researcher, CSIRO's Mary Ann Augustin, said the broccoli was high in protein and fibre, and health-promoting bioactive phytochemicals, making it an ideal candidate for powder development.

"The powders are an option for farmers who want

to produce value-added vegetable ingredients for the lucrative functional food markets," Dr Augustin said.

"The broccoli powder has already been used for the production of extruded snacks with high vegetable content.

"Prototype extruded snacks with 20-100 per cent vegetable content were displayed during National Science Week at the Queen Victoria

Market last year and were well-received by parents and even by kids."

The broccoli powder, and associated extruded snacks, are being developed as part of a larger research and development project which aims to reduce vegetable waste by creating healthy food products from 'ugly' produce.

The next steps, Dr Augustin said, are to take the powder into further product development and consumer sensory evaluation trials.

"The CSIRO team and Hort Innovation are discussing potential commercial applications with produce growers and grower groups across Australia who are interested in getting the powder on the market," she said.

John Said, managing director of Fresh Select, a leading broccoli producer, is excited by the commercial opportunities available through the development of the value-added broccoli ingredients and products.

"I see this project as the emerging new food trend," Mr Said said.

"Australians don't eat enough vegetables and farmers across Australia will have access to an alternative market whilst improving farm yields and sustainability.

"They will also be contributing to healthier lifestyles!"





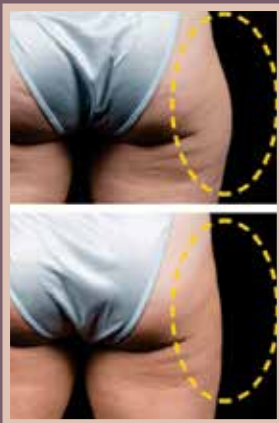

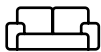

Hello Leonie,

Reading your column each week and seeing how the community opens up their taboo problems to you has inspired me to write in about my dark secret to see if you have an answer for me too. I just can't talk to anyone about this because it is, I think, socially and morally nasty.

I absolutely dread having to deal with my two adult children. I don't like them. I know it's a horrible thing to say but this is how my husband and I feel. They are nothing like me or my husband and I can't relate to them in any way.

My daughter, a graphic designer, is very well off and a mother of two little girls. She is self centred, rude and only visits me when she needs my help with something, which is normally help of a domestic kind. Usually it's babysitting, waiting for and letting trades men in or helping her with appointments for her daughters. Her daughters are complete brats. They swear, disrespect our house and property and have not once said thank you Nan and Pop for anything.

My son is now in his thirties, is not married and sees women as disposable and as inferior. He only comes around when he wants to borrow his father's classic car to impress girls. We found out that the last time he borrowed this much loved car, he actually rented it out to a wedding party without our knowledge. He is also mean and has a short temper to the point where we are scared of him.

Our children are nothing like us and they both owe us large sums of money but refuse to pay it back saying it's a parents job to help out.

We are good people and we feel like someone else have our kids and we have these two monsters. We have been to counselling and we also had family counselling. My husband and I did everything we were told in therapy but the kids both laughed and called it all pathetic.

We want to sell up and move into a retirement complex so that we don't have to look after the yard and a big house but both kids say that they will miss out when we die as these places reabsorb a lot of the purchase price.

I am at the end of my rope and my husband has just been diagnosed with stress and anxiety. I know that you will have an answer. What would you do?

Hi Beverly,

I am quite fearful for you because I believe that this situation could quite easily deteriorate into an elder abuse nightmare where you lose more and more power over your assets and your health. I would suggest that you get some legal advice as to how to prevent your children from harassing you and find out who you can call when you need back up. I would encourage getting all your ducks in a row NOW. You may be surprised at the amount of support available to you and I am going to email you some numbers tonight.

I would say to hell with what others in the community think and I would take any and all measures to stop these two people from ruining my happiness and my husband's health. It's that old age argument of nature vs. nurture. Many truly loving and amazing people have brought up individuals that they are frightened of and disgusted with. You have tried to talk to your children and you have tried family therapy. The thing is that with any kind of therapy, I feel that it can only work if all parties are willing and truly want change to occur. So what would I do?

I would tell my daughter that her father is ill and that we are both of an age now where we are making ourselves a priority. I would say that neither I nor her father would be available for domestic duties because we are officially retiring from everyone else's problems and are going to focus on ourselves. She will most likely whinge, bleat and carry on like blue bloody murder. Let her go. Tell her it's not up for debate. If she got abusive, I would hang up on her or remove myself from her company.

I would not tell these kids what I plan to do with MY home. I would sell it and buy into that retirement village. This would give you added protection from your son as these are gated communities and they won't tolerate any abusive behaviours and I feel that there is safety in numbers. I would suggest that you and your hubby have a strong resolve to protect each other and demonstrate to your children that you guys are united in the one goal of putting yourselves first. If you have enough funds left over after the sale perhaps you can take yourselves off somewhere exotic and glamorous to rest and recuperate. Before there was a family, there were the two of you in love and the two of you still have each other so make the most of it. Frankly who cares what's left of the estate for these two to fight over.

## ABOUT YOUR WATER BILL

- The bulk water charge to rise by 3.5 per cent every year until 2021
- Unitywater releases its 2018-19 prices



At least it's consistent. Water prices across the South East will rise at a set percentage for the next three years following recommendations from the Queensland Competition Authority (QCA).

The State Government determines bulk water prices across the 11 SEQ council areas (including ours) and directed the QCA to review the costs of the sole supplier, Seqwater, and recommend prices for consideration.

Bulk water charges account for about 30% of an average household's water and sewerage bill.

Minister for Natural Resources Mines and Energy, Dr Anthony Lynham has written to all SEQ councils advising them of the price of bulk water for the next three years.

"Our investment in bulk water infrastructure as a result of the millennium drought provides South East Queensland with long-term water security and resilience against future droughts and floods," he said.

Last year the independent QCA was asked to review Seqwater's proposed bulk water costs and to recommend prices for bulk water for the next three years.

The State Government asked the QCA to present pricing options that would see a common price reached by all councils. After carefully considering their own report, the bulk water supply code and stakeholder submissions, the QCA suggested two solutions.

"Eight of the councils in SEQ have already reached the common price, with the Sunshine Coast, Noosa and Redland City needing to make up some more ground," QCA Chairman Professor Roy Green said.

"The State Government has asked the QCA to present two pricing options, one that would see the common price reached by all councils in 2019-20 and another where the common price would be reached in 2020-21."

Under the first option, the current bulk water price for the eight councils paying the common price – Brisbane, Gold Coast, Ipswich, Lockyer Valley, Logan, Moreton Bay, Scenic Rim and Somerset – of \$2.82 per kilolitre would rise by 5.2% in 2018-19 and 2.5% in each of the next two years.

"This would mean that the bulk water component of the bill of an average household – using 160 kilolitres per year – in these council areas would rise by \$23.20 in 2018-19 and \$12 in each of the next two years," Professor Roy Green said.

"The price for Sunshine Coast and Noosa would increase by 8% in 2018-19, 7.4% in 2019-20 and 2.5% in 2020-21, while the price for Redland City would rise by 9.3%, 8.5% and 2.5%.

"Under this option, the bulk water component of an average household's bill in Sunshine Coast and Noosa would increase by \$33.60 in 2018-19, \$33.76 the following year and \$12 in 2020-21. In Redland City, the increases would be \$38.08 for each of the first two years and \$12 in 2020-21.

"Under the second option, the common price applying to the group of eight councils would rise by 3.5% in each of the three years, resulting in increases for the average household of \$16 to \$17 each year."

The second option would provide more gradual increases for the other three council areas – over a three-year span instead of two – with Sunshine Coast and Noosa seeing price increases of 6.5%, 6.1% and 5.7%, while Redland City consumers would see rises of 7.3%, 6.8% and 6.4%.

"This would see average households facing increases of about \$27 each year for Sunshine Coast and Noosa and \$30 each year for Redland City."

"Under this second option, a common price of \$3.12 per kilolitre would apply to all 11 councils in 2020-21. Under the 2018 bulk water prices all SEQ councils (except Sunshine Coast, Noosa, and Redlands) will see bills increase by 3.5 per cent per year until June 30 2021 – approximately \$16 per year for an average household.

### UNITYWATER 2018-19 PRICES FOR MORETON BAY CUSTOMERS

Unitywater also released its 2018-19 prices, stating an ongoing commitment to keep costs as low as possible for customers in the Moreton Bay region.

"Unfortunately, the bulk water price set by the State Government will increase by 3.5%. For the average Moreton Bay customer this adds approximately \$15 to the total water and sewerage bill from 1 July 2018," Unity Water said in a statement released last Thursday.

Overall this means an increase in the total average water and sewerage bill of around \$7 per annum.

### SUBSIDIES FOR ELIGIBLE PENSIONERS

The Queensland Government provides eligible pensioners a subsidy of up to \$120 each year off the cost of water access and usage charges for properties in South East Queensland.

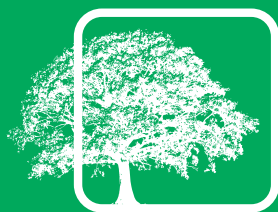
